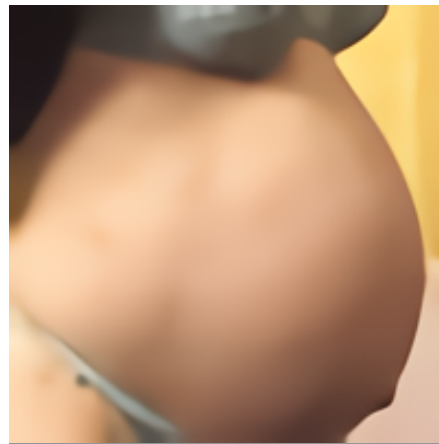
regular feature by the time we fully get up and running. Stay tuned to find out how to send in your letters!

Meet the Artist

Interview with the artists behind your favourite pregnancy-related works

Pregnancy art is a very popular area and its with great pleasure for us to provide you, dear reader, with exclusive interviews with some of the best artists out there.

This issue, we will be talking to none other than PreggoBellyLover (PBL for short)! Let's begin:

Please note that for the purpose of this sample issue, some of the questions were generated by AI.

How did you become interested in pregnancy art?

PBL: I've always been fascinated by pregnancy and the look of how it transforms a person. The beauty and I wanted to capture and celebrate this incredible transformation through my art.

Do you have a preferred medium or technique when creating pregnancy art?

PBL: I mostly work with 3D models for my characters and art. I've zero drawing talent and 3D modelling provides an easy way to make my art.

One question we do like to ask is how long have you been creating pregnancy art?

PBL: 12 years. Yes, 12 long years I've been in this field. I've enjoyed every moment of it and I hope to continue to provide art of my characters and stories for many more years to follow!

Can you describe your artistic process from start to finish when working on a pregnancy art piece?

PBL: Once I've come up with an idea (can take some time!), I would then fire up my 3D editor of choice and get to work. I sometimes have reference images to ensure I get poses right and to make things look as natural as possible. I'm not a professional mind you but at least people seem to enjoy my work!

Are there any specific themes or concepts that you like to explore in your pregnancy art?

PBL: I mostly create works for the modern era but I do dive in to sci-fi works from time to time. I also do some fantasy works, mostly involving giantesses and hyper pregnancy, but I do try and keep things as close to normal and

modern as possible.

Are there any specific challenges or considerations you face when creating art related to pregnancy?

PBL: Nothing in particular. As I mentioned previously, I do try and keep things normal or close to what is considered normal. I guess one of the challenges is ensuring that the 3D models at least look good and there's no issues with clothing clipping through the model or scenery, the latter of which can be quite bothersome at times! Other

than that, rendering times can drag on depending on the content but it is 2023 and there's other things to do during that downtime!

Do you offer any personalised or custom pregnancy art services?

PBL: Currently no. I just don't have the time or energy lately for it. Doesn't mean to say I won't open up to custom works, although as most of my models are pre-made, it's difficult for me to create say a model of a video game character and use her for custom art. Never say never though! If I do open up for commissions, I shall announce it on my Twitter/X and deviantArt page.

Can you share any memorable experiences or stories from your journey as a pregnancy artist?

PBL: Just the community as a whole really! Everyone is supportive and appreciative of my work and especially my characters, trying not to sound big headed here!

Do you have any favourite pregnancy art pieces that you've created? If so, what makes them special to you?

PBL: My current favourite is a piece titled "Country Lane Sunset" where it pictures my popular character Ami against the setting sun in the country. I just love how the light was captured against her and the near silhouette it creates of her. Easily one of the tops in my view.

Are there any particular artists or art movements that have influenced your approach to pregnancy art?

PBL: I don't wish to call out anyone in particular! Besides there's MANY artists that I follow who have all but inspired me over the years in my work. There are also group collaborations such as "Mayternity" and "Pregtober" for the months of May and October respectively. I occasionally take part in those if my mind is working properly to create art!

Are there any future projects or collaborations related to pregnancy art that you're excited about?

PBL: Not at the moment but I'm always open for collaborations and projects, if they're within my

technical limitations of course.

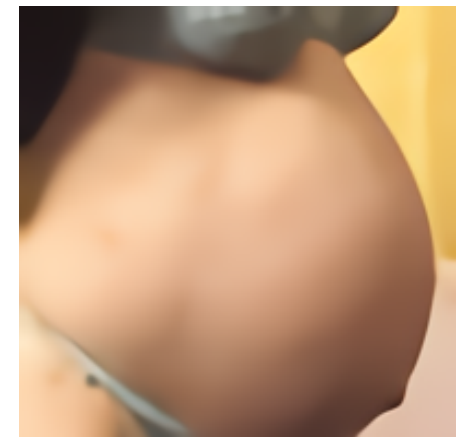

Interview Corner

Featuring: Ami

We speak to the lady with the eternal bump

When it comes to pregnant models here at Bump, no one is more famous and popular than our beloved Ami. In this 3 part interview, we will ask Ami about her modelling career, her time spent as a video game streamer and her life with an ever lasting bump! Let's begin.

Modelling Career

First of all, thank you for your time today, Ami. For our first part, we'd like to talk to you about your modelling career;

How has being pregnant affected your modelling career?

Ami: At first, I was very self-conscious about going in to modelling, "would I be accepted?" "would people like how I looked?" "could I pull off wearing this outfit?". But you don't know until you try, so I did and here I am today!

How did you feel about doing fully naked photo shoots?

Ami: Scary and very embarrassing! I'm sure everyone is like that during their first nude scene but my very first shoot was right here with Bump and their staff are so extremely supportive and caring. The fact they provide the option for the photographer to be either a man or a woman is a bonus since I know people would get very shy posing for a man.

What challenges, if any, have you faced in finding maternity wear for photo shoots?

Ami: So far, none really. Most if not all of the shoots are done with the belly on display so most of us are just in lingerie or underwear for most of the photos, with the exception of clothing reviews of course.

Have you noticed any changes in the way you approach posing or working on set during pregnancy?

Ami: Posing most definitely. With a tummy as large as mine, it can be very difficult to get in to certain positions or even down on to a bed. Fortunately, the staff here are always on hand to help and assist.

What advice would you give to other expecting models who are navigating the industry?

Ami: All I can say is, if you are confident with yourself and want to get in to modelling? Just go for it. It is a nervous and sometimes anxiety inducing time but once you get in to it, it can be so much fun and entertaining.

Video Game Streaming

For our next series of questions, we'd like to ask about your time spent streaming video games in your current situation.

How long have you been in to video games and how long have you been streaming?

Ami: Probably as far back as I can remember. I've always liked games ever since I saw a family relative play on their console. After seeing that, I just had to hop on board! As for streaming? I'd say a year or two at this point, fairly recent.

What type of games do you stream?

Ami: Mostly casual stuff like platformers, RPG's, racing games. Nothing that gets me too stressed out. Well, much at least!

Do viewers often request to see your belly on stream?

Ami: Frequently. So frequently in fact that I made it a stream goal where after the threshold was met, I would pause the game and show off my belly during what we've come to call "Belly Time"! Plus it's a nice break from the gaming and the viewers get an eyeful!

Do your viewers enjoy both your gaming and belly time?

Ami: Some do leave after belly time but a vast majority do hang around and watch me continue the game. We also have chat time where I just basically talk with the viewers regarding whatever topic.

Have you done any collaborations? Are you planning any?

Ami: None yet but I would love to do a collaboration at some point. Who with? No idea! We'll have to wait and see.

And for our final series of questions, we'd like to ask you about that wonderful tummy of yours!

How has it felt living with such a round belly for all these years?

Ami: At first, very challenging and honestly, quite worrying! I feared on losing my independence and had to rely on others to help me get around. But over time, I learnt to cope with it and I feel I can do pretty

much anything, within limits of course!

Was the growth slow, fast, gradual?

Ami: My belly developed over a regular 9 month pregnancy, although it did grow a bit more during month 10. After which, it stopped and, well this is the result!

Now we've said, and even yourself have said, "pregnancy". But you've had scans and medical examinations, all of which returned negative. Can you share your feelings about this?

Ami: I've used the term pregnancy to describe myself because that's how it looks and feels. Scans show just static and over time, I just grew to accept that I look pregnant and that I should get in to pregnant modelling.

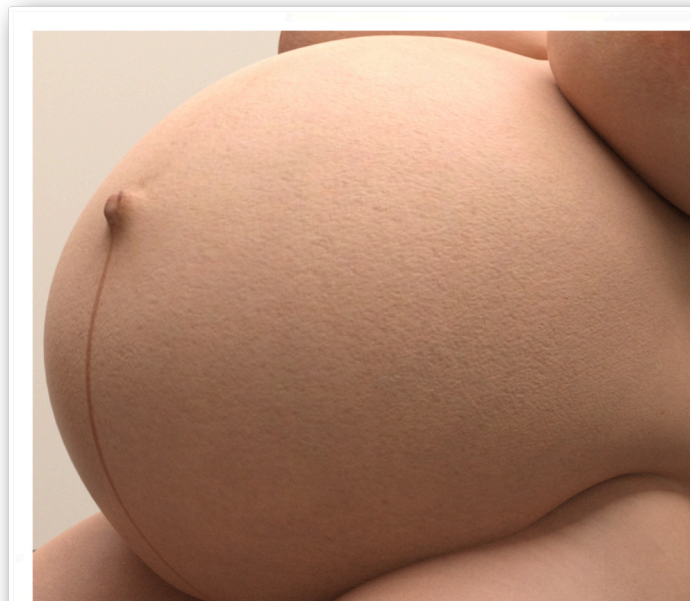
Has anyone expressed jealousy at your eternal round tummy?

Ami: Surprisingly, yes! I believe there's a couple of people known to Bump as well who are frequent surrogates and they do enjoy the experience. They do wish that they could have a perma-bump but that's not up to me!

And finally, do you get a lot of requests from people to do things with your belly? Can you list some of the more notable ones?

Ami: Ho boy, yes! I'm constantly being asked if people can touch it, rub it, kiss it. Some requests involve asking me to perform a belly dance, bounce up and down, suck it in/stick it out, slap it (gently of course), apply lotion and the list just goes on! I don't mind of course, at least I'm providing entertainment to folks!

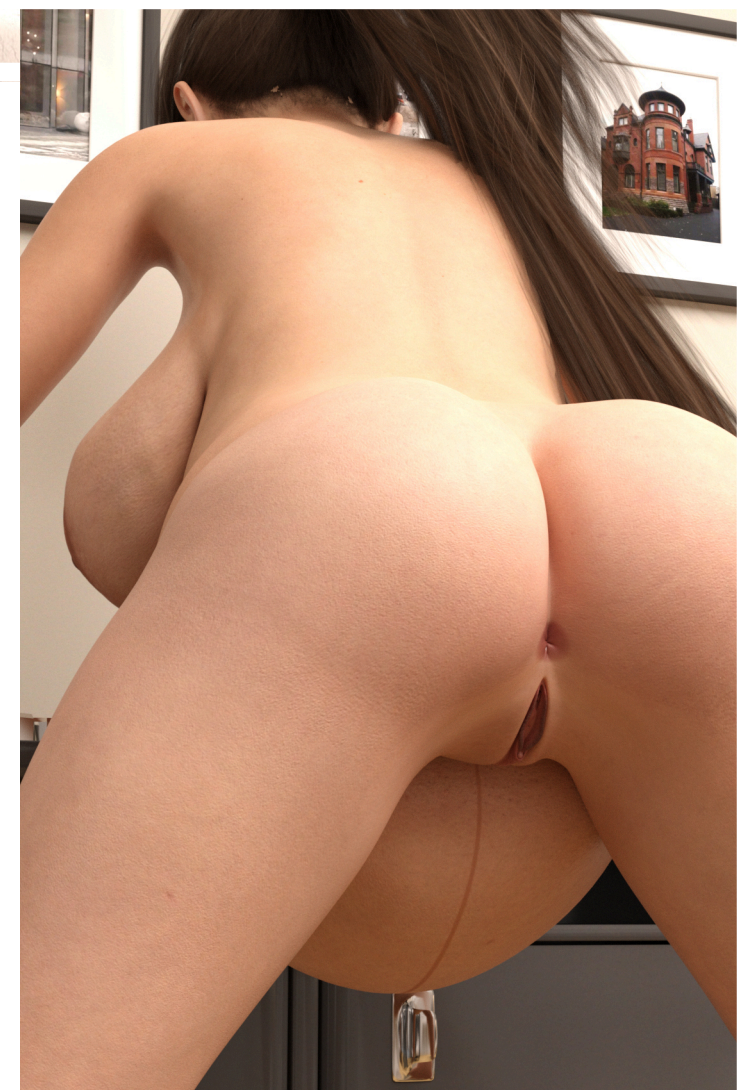

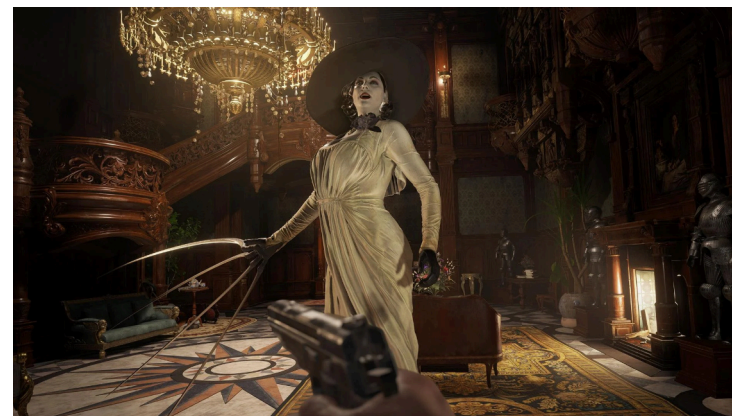
